Sugar runs

May 5-7, 12-14, 19-21, and 26-28

SUGAR OPENS

Love, murder, dancing girls, dapper gang members, and, yes, crossdressing men. Interested? Good, because all of these things can be found in our final production of the season, *Sugar*, opening on May 5th for a four-week run.

Sugar is the stage musical adaptation of the 1959 film, Some Like It Hot, which starred Marilyn Monroe, Jack Lemmon, and Tony Curtis. It first premiered on Broadway in 1972 and has been revived several times in theatres all over the world, including Mexico City, London, and Copenhagen. A U.S. national tour ran in 1992 with Tony Curtis playing the role of millionaire Osgood Fielding, Jr.

The story begins with two out-of-work musicians, Joe and Jerry, who, while trying to find a paying job, accidently witness the St. Valentine's Day

massacre. Narrowly avoiding the same fate, they escape from Spats Palazzo and his gang by disguising themselves as women and join an all-girl band heading for a gig in Miami Beach. It's meant to be a short-term solution until Joe falls in love with the lead singer of the band, the gorgeous Sugar Kane, a slight problem because she only knows him as his alter-ego, Josephine. Of course, it isn't long before Spats and his gang find them and the truth about everything is revealed.

Does Joe get the girl? Does Spats get Joe and Jerry? How will the story end? You won't find the answer here, that wouldn't be any fun! The only way to satisfy your curiosity is to attend one of the twelve performances that run from May 5th through May 28th. As always, Friday and Saturday evening performances begin at 8:00 pm, Sunday matinees at 2:30 pm, so there are plenty of opportunities.

The cast has been working incredibly hard for the past seven weeks singing, dancing, acting, and learning how to walk in high heels while the crew has been building an amazingly versatile set and getting everything just right. Choose one or more of the dates (again, there are twelve to choose from) and come out to support your fellow Guild members in what promises to be a satisfying end of the season!

IN MEMORY OF VAL SISTO

Val Sisto, an Honorary Member of The Players Guild of Dearborn, died quietly on April 26, two days after a fatal fall at home, and a week after his 95th birthday. He was surrounded by his children when he passed.

Val joined the Guild in 1975 and participated on stage, back stage, and from the director's chair through the 70s, 80, and 90s. More recently, he has been



on our stage in *The Goodbye Girl, Damn Yankees, Fiddler on the Roof, Children of Eden, Man of La Mancha,* and *Inherit the Wind.*







